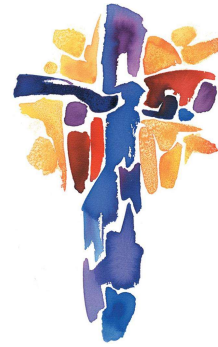

Love in Action

Through the history of First Presbyterian Church-Willmar, people have made estate gifts a part of their end of life planning. There are many ways to do this, and we are providing this material to remind you of the people who have gone before and how they have thought to provide for the church and the mission of the church. Some gifts have been very large, some have been smaller but all show a strong faith and love of God.

As part of Wills Emphasis month, we will provide a series of estate gift stories in the announcements, highlighting one estate or endowment gift weekly.

Walters Fund: The will of Ruth Walters provided that the residual of her estate be divided into two gifts for the church. The first sum provided an amount to be used in capital construction. The will stated the money would be held at the Presbyterian Foundation and the Foundation was to receive requests and determine that they met the guidelines. If the money was not used in 10 years, it was to be added to the second sum. It was used as a part of building projects within the required 10 years. The second sum, close to half a million dollars was placed in an endowment that was to benefit theological study by people "known to First Presbyterian Church." The interest is housed in an account titled Walters Income Fund. The funds have been used through the years for seminary tuition for the son-in-law of a long time member, Bruce Kaihoi; a member and staff member, Elaine Boyd, classes by members who have worked toward or completed work in the lay pastor program; and some of the continuing education opportunities that meet the qualifications of our installed pastors since institution of the fund. Who knows what other opportunities will present themselves.

The Salvation Army of Willmar will be participating in the Summer Food Service Program this summer, which is set to start Monday. The Summer Food Service Program, a function of the U.S. Department of Agriculture, is designed to provide meals for children who depend on free school lunches during the summer when school is not in session. Lunch will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis to anyone under the age of 18. There are several locations where meals are served at various times on varying days. The program will run through August 18th.

The Red Cross: We were unable to have a Red Cross Blood Drive this summer because of the uncertainty of air conditioning in John Knox Hall. United Methodists have stepped up to host a July Red Cross Blood Drive. It will be Thursday, July 6 from 1pm-7pm. Please consider giving blood at this donor site or at another site this

summer. Blood is always needed. We will be in contact with the Methodists and help them as needed. If you have questions, please contact Doris Cogelow 979-4967.



Pentecost Offering

As one of the four Special Offerings of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), the Pentecost Offering unites us in a churchwide effort to support young people in Christ and inspire them to share their faith, ideas, and unique gifts with
